Curriculum Purpose:

Context	KEVI HWGA:	Study of Classics not only illuminates the past but is entirely relevant to the present. Students who study Classics will increase their analytical and critical thinking skills as they examine and analyse ancient cultures, which improve their writing and oral communication abilities. Studying Classics exposes students to important and powerful literary knowledge so that students can join the discussions of society and ultimately make knowledgeable and meaningful contributions to society.
	KS3	This combined curriculum aims to build knowledge in Year 7 and Year 8. The curriculum aims to equip students with powerful knowledge that will form a solid foundation for further study, yet that will also provide students with knowledge to make meaningful contributions to society. Lessons of Classics are planned throughout the KS3 curriculum to develop students' understanding from Year 7 and Year 8 in a sequenced way.
	Year7, Year 8 Links	Students of each year group at KS3 will read and be encouraged to appreciate the depth and power of the literary heritage through reading a range of enjoyable texts reflective of classic literature, covering Greek mythology and the development of the epic. Students will draw upon the seminal knowledge explored in KS3 and can apply this to their study of English Literature from Renaissance, Romantics, Victorian, Edwardian to Modern literature in KS4 and KS5.
