

# Options for students that are unhappy with their Centre Assessed Grade

Since the announcement by the Government that students will now be able to use their Centre Assessed Grade or their Calculated Grade (whichever is higher), no clear guidance has been issued, but to the best of our knowledge the options for students are as follows.

Ofqual have confirmed that students cannot challenge their individual centre assessment grades this year, as any appeal would have to be undertaken by someone better placed than your teachers to judge your likely grade if assessments had taken place. In the unique circumstances of this summer, Ofqual do not believe there is any such person. However, if you or others have concerns about bias, discrimination or another factor that suggests that a school did not behave with care or integrity when determining the centre assessment grade and/or rank order information then these should be raised with your school first.
