Welcome to MyTutor - we're delighted to be offering your child live online lessons each week that are personalised to suit their needs.

MyTutor matches students with a kind and friendly tutor studying at a top university somewhere in the UK. Our tutors are talented, bright, and have recently sat their GCSEs and A Levels, so they understand how stressful exams can be.

Your child has 2 weekly My Tutor lessons starting on the 22nd June 2021 will take place on Tuesday and Thursday at 15.15 till 16.15 until the 12th August 2021, sessions after the 16th July will continue at home.

Please note the following key steps:

1. Use Google Chrome or Firefox web browsers on PCs, or Safari on Macs or iPads (MyTutor won't work on Internet Explorer)
2. Your child logs in using their username and password (below) at www.mytutor.co.uk/schools/login
3. Once logged in, clicking the 'Launch' button takes your child into the lesson
4. When you click 'Launch', this will run a quick connection test - make sure to allow access to the microphone and camera (these can be turned off later)
5. If a tutor doesn't arrive straightaway, a cover tutor will be on their way to take your child's lesson so make sure they don't log out
6. If any tech problems crop up, trying refreshing the page
7. Students will be issued with their username and password prior to the first session.
