



The proposals form part of the Department for Education’s (DfE) ‘School Rebuilding Programme’ that seeks to undertake major rebuilding and refurbishment projects targeted at school and sixth form college buildings that are considered to be in deteriorating condition.

A building survey has been undertaken, and confirms that the existing accommodation from the 1960s is not sufficient for the school to deliver the curriculum in several key areas, due to inefficient spatial configurations, poor movement between blocks, and a lack of external space. The appraisal also noted that the school also has limited internal and external spaces that can be utilised by the community, something that the school wishes to improve on in the future.

Therefore a complete school replacement (with the exception of the Sixth Form Centre) is being proposed for this project.
