



The main building is a simple L-shape with a central circulation zone running through its spine.

The Ground floor plan is simply laid out with distinct visitors' entrance easily identifiable from the site entrance. The first impression is a generous double height entrance area with access to an interview room, accessible WC and a meeting/ conference room directly from the public zone. Views through to the centrally located Library overlooking the central courtyard provides visual connectivity from the reception area to the pupil zone beyond.

A separate pupil entrance, generously sized and passively supervised by the general admin and strategically located office space provides a welcoming approach for the students adjacent to the main entrance.
